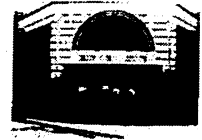

Dear Counsel and Mr. Windsor:

Attached you will find a copy of the following document:

- Signed and file marked copy of the Order Granting Non-Party Google, Inc.'s Special Exceptions to Plaintiff's First Amended Verified Petition.

Please be advised that Plaintiff's Objections to Google, Inc.'s Proposed Order and Motion for Reconsideration of Google, Inc.'s Special Exceptions file marked March 6, 2014 shall be treated by the trial court as a "reconsideration" of the preceding signed and file marked Order, and as such, during the review process the matter is subject to a possible in-court hearing at the discretion of the trial court.

Further, please consider this correspondence to be a *memorandum ruling* which provides as follows:

1. **IT IS ORDERED** that effective immediately, all proceedings in the above entitled and numbered lawsuit are hereby *stayed* and remain on hold, including legal deadlines applicable to any party, until such time as the trial court further examines the legal implications and applicability of the Order and vexatious litigant injunction directed against William M. Windsor dated July 15, 2011 and issued by Thomas W. Thrash, Jr., United States District Judge for the Northern District of Georgia, a copy of said Order being attached as Exhibit "A" to this trial court's signed and file marked Order referenced herein-above.

2. The stay imposed by way of court Order in the preceding Paragraph 1 will be referred to as the/this "stay of proceedings" dated March 10, 2014.
3. This stay of proceedings applies without prejudice, by way of example only and not by way of any limitation, to – (i) any of Plaintiff's pending motions, requests for hearings, or court dates; (ii) Defendant Sean D. Fleming's Motion to Dismiss; and (iii) the various requests received by the trial court for hearings on special exceptions, other than Google's special exceptions which were previously heard and ruled upon by the court.
4. It is anticipated that this stay of proceedings shall remain in effect for a relatively short period, until such time as the trial court's schedule permits the further examination and related ruling contemplated in Paragraph 1 above.

The trial court respectfully assigns the law firm of Jackson Walker, L.L.P. with the responsibility to forward a copy of this correspondence, along with a copy of the attached and filed marked Order signed by the trial court, to the attorneys and parties of record which are identified in the service matrix contained on Pages 2 and 3 of Attorney Shannon Zmud Teicher's letter dated February 28, 2014.
